Connecticut Debate Association November 14, 2015 Tournament Amity, Housatonic Valley and New Canaan High School

On behalf of Amity High School and Coach Cara McConnell, Housatonic Valley Regional High School and Coach John Lizzi, and New Canaan High School and Coach Kristine Goldhawk, I would like to invite you to attend our second tournament of the 2015-16 season on Saturday, November 14. We will follow our standard tournament format.

Please read the following items carefully:

1. If you plan to attend, please email us AS SOON AS POSSIBLE with an estimate of the number of debaters you plan to bring. This estimate need not be accurate. We would like to have a preliminary count by Thursday evening, November 5, so we can have the correct number of packets printed.

2. You must register your teams and judges through <u>tabroom.com</u>. Instructions for using tabroom.com for CDA can be found here: <u>http://ctdebate.org/PDFs/Using%20Tabroom.pdf</u> or you can use the online instructions. We use <u>tabroom.com</u> for all tournaments.

The tournament entry on <u>tabroom.com</u> has six events: Varsity, Novice and Observer for each of the three host schools. You may choose the tournament you would like to attend by registering your debaters in the appropriate events for that host school. We may ask teams that are nearly equidistant from two hosts to switch if registrations are unbalanced.

Note that each tournament also has two judge groups—Novice and Varsity. Please consider the experience of your judges when you enter them into a group.

The tournament will be open for registration on Monday, September 28 at 8AM. You may make changes up through the morning of the tournament. We would like each school to take responsibility for making sure their entries are correct, rather than having to change them ourselves on the morning of the tournament.

3. With three hosts, we have space for over 600 debaters so we expect to have room for everyone who wants to attend.

4. Please abide by the rules for Novice eligibility (unchanged from last year):

The Novice division will be open to Freshman and Sophomores, regardless of experience or record. They may qualify and participate as Novices in State Finals both years. However, they may move up to Varsity at any time if they or their coach choose, and once having moved up, may not return to Novice. Coaches are encouraged to move Sophomores up to Varsity if they have been successful as a Freshman, but are not required to do so.

Juniors who have never debated before in CDA may participate as Novices in their first regular CDA tournament. Otherwise they may only debate in Varsity. They may not participate in State Finals except in Varsity. They may only qualify for State Finals while debating in Varsity.

Seniors may not participate as Novices in any CDA tournament.

5. To qualify for State Finals, a debater must win a trophy at a regular tournament, or go 3-0 at two regular tournaments. In other words, simply going 3-0 at one tournament without winning a trophy will not qualify.
