## Please read the following items carefully:

1. We have room for 428 debaters. This is about 50 less than we had in November, our last full tournament date. Depending on who signs up, we may have to ask some of the larger delegations to limit their numbers.

I would appreciate an email or signup by this coming weekend, January 27, so we have an idea on numbers and can adjust locations as necessary.

2. The geography is also a bit tricky. In order to get a good distribution, unless you have a pressing reason, I would ask schools to sign up as follows:

2. You must register your teams and judges through <a href="mailto:tabroom.com">tabroom.com</a>. We will be using <a href="mailto:tabroom.com">tabroom.com</a> for registration for all tournaments. The tournament entry on <a href="mailto:tabroom.com">tabroom.com</a> has six events, Varsity, Novice and Observer for each of Daniel Hand and New Canaan.

The tournament is currently open for registration at 8AM on Monday, January 22.

3. Please abide by the rules for Novice eligibility (unchanged from last year):

The Novice division will be open to Freshman and Sophomores, regardless of experience or record. They may qualify and participate as Novices in State Finals both years. However, they may move up to Varsity at any time if they or their coach choose, and once having moved up,

may not return to Novice. Coaches are encouraged to move Sophomores up to Varsity if they have been successful as a Freshman, but are not required to do so.

Juniors who have never debated before in CDA may participate as Novices in their first regular CDA tournament. Otherwise they may only debate in Varsity. They may not participate in State Finals except in Varsity. They may only qualify for State Finals while debating in Varsity.

Seniors may not participate as Novices in any CDA tournament.

- 4. To qualify for State Finals, a debater must win a trophy at a regular tournament, or go 3-0 at two regular tournaments. In other words, simply going 3-0 at one tournament without winning a trophy will not qualify.
