Regarding the tournament, please read the following carefully:

- 1. If you have qualifying debaters you should have received an email with their names and explanation of the rules for pairing them into teams. If you believe there is an error in the list you received or you have questions about forming teams, please email me. Students with questions should confer with their coaches rather than email me directly.
- 2. You must register your teams and judges through <a href="www.tabroom.com">www.tabroom.com</a>. The tournament will be open for registration on Monday, March 10 at 8AM, and your entries and changes must be in by Friday, March 21 at 6PM.

PLEASE REMEMBER TO REGISTER YOUR JUDGES! We ask that all judges at State Finals have prior experience.

- 3. We will not pair students without partners across schools on the morning of the tournament. Coaches should be prepared to re-pair their debaters or bring replacements if some debaters cannot attend at the last minute.
- 4. Observers are welcome, and should be registered through <a href="www.tabroom.com">www.tabroom.com</a>. We will provide packets for debaters coming to observe who have registered. All students must be accompanied by an adult who will be responsible for them, and you must comply with any rules the students' school has regarding attendance at interscholastic events.
